
What is a field journal?





A Monarch butterfly will migrate approximately _____ miles from Canada and Northern United States to their overwintering grounds in Mexico. They begin this long trip south in mid-August and usually arrive to Mexico in early November. It will take about two months, on average, for an individual Monarch to make this journey. Once they have reached Mexico, they will hibernate for the winter months. During migration, they will face predators, human contact, and weather delays.

Cattle Ranching/Cattle Branding


